Library Statute.

MADE under the *University of Technology Act.*

1. Library Committee.

- (1) The Academic Board shall establish a Library Committee.
- (2) The Library Committee shall meet—
 - (a) at least once during each term; and
 - (b) at such other times as the Chairman of the Library Committee or the Librarian requests.

2. Functions of Library Committee.

The Library Committee—

- (a) shall advise the Academic Board on library policies in relation to the development of library facilities for teaching and research in the University; and
- (b) shall advise the Academic Board and the Council on the development of library services for Papua New Guinea in technical branches of learning; and
- (c) shall make recommendations to the Academic Board, the Vice-Chancellor and the Librarian concerning—
 - (i) the fiscal needs of the Library; and
 - (ii) the expenditure of funds available to the Library; and
- (d) shall recommend to the Academic Board rules or orders—
 - (i) for the conduct of students, staff and other users in the Library or in any departmental library; and
 - (ii) for the storage, care and preservation of books in the Library or any departmental library; and
 - (iii) for the borrowing from or use of books in the Library or in departmental libraries by staff and students and other users; and
- (e) has such other powers and duties as are conferred or imposed on it by any other Statute or by any rule or order.

3. Administration of the Library.

The Librarian shall carry out the administration of the Library.
